Abstract

Colonial Impact on Tamil-speaking Communities of the Eastern Province of Sri Lanka.

Today, Sri Lanka is reaping the consequences of the political, economic, and social impact that

occurred during the administration of Western colonial powers from 1597 to 1948. Similarly,

the Tamil-speaking communities of the Eastern Province also faced many challenges, threats

and lot of hardships during the colonial administration, and still, the impact reflect in their

culture, traditions and lifestyle.

The research examines how colonialism affected the Tamil-speaking communities, what the

changes were and a comparative study regarding the influence of colonialism on the Tamil and

Muslim communities of the Eastern Province. In addition, it is analyzed through two research

questions: whether there had been a radical change due to European colonial influence on

impact over the Tamil-speaking communities in the Eastern Province and which Tamil-

speaking community was highly affected due to European colonial influences in this province.

For this study, the data is evaluated through the historical methodology and the qualitative

approach, that included analysis of various documents, such as native literature records, palm

leaf manuscripts, oral stories with folklore, Dutch Tombo, British colonial records,

archaeological evidence, field visits and interviews with various experts and aged ones. These

historical sources help to understand the impact that incurred in the Colonial administration of

the Eastern Province.

Therefore, the research reveals that the uniqueness of the Tamil-speaking communities in the

province were neglected in various areas, particularly the traditional education system, cultural

values, socio, economic features, religious practices and indigenous technologies due to the

European influences. Though the Colonialization brought various changes in the Eastern

Province, all communities experienced some positive consequences that brought development

in the socio, economic and cultural areas for instance the country received modern education,

transportation facilities, development of infrastructures and expansion of foreign affairs.
