- OFFICIAL NAME:
- Republic of Poland (short name: Poland) -> in Polish: Rzeczpospolita Polska (short name: Polska).
- OFFICIAL LANGUAGE: Polish.
- CURRENCY:
 - The official currency in Poland is złoty (PLN). One złoty = 100 groszy.
 - Notes and coins are of the following denominations: Coins: 1, 2, 5, 10, 20 and 50 groszy, 1, 2 and 5 złotych; Banknotes: 10, 20, 50, 100, 200 and 500 złotych.
 - The exchange rate for 1 euro is approximately 4.7 PLN
 - The exchange rate for 1 dollar US is approximately 4.45 PLN.



- 1. copy of passport
- 2. copy of dormitory letter
- 3. Zaswiadczenie (acceptance letter) from doctoral school (polish and english)
- 4 letter of scholarship (in polish + english) (a letter that showed how much you received the amount of scholarship)
- 5. insurance health: ZUS
- 6. bank statement
- 7. payment receipt of residence card
- 8. zaswiadczenie from pesel offfice
- 9. photography (4 pieces)









Health insurance and Healthcare

Public health care services

- For EU/EFTA Citizen: don't have to pay the insurance in Poland because the University already paid
- For Non-EU Citizen: must apply NFZ (https://www.nfz.gov.pl/) National Health Fund.
 - Documents needed: pesel number (arrange in city hall), passport and letter of Acceptance as Doctoral Student
 - Price per month: PLN 55,80
