

FORMAT OF ARTICLES

1. Articles should be between 11 -15 typeset pages
2. The main text should be between 5000-8000 words (excluding Abstract, Methods, tables, figures References, and relevant legends)
3. Title should NOT exceed 20 words, and portray the main idea of the article using a single sentence
4. The abstract should NOT BE more than 250 words
5. All articles must be submitted in English with the abstract in Sinhala/Tamil
Accepted Fonts: English - Times New Roman
 Sinhala - Iskoola Potha (Unicode)
 Tamil - Nilmala (Unicode)
 Font size - 12 pts
6. Authors are required to submit the article in PDF format as well as in MS word format for reviewing and editing purposes.

Abstract

Please do not include any references in your Abstract. Make sure it serves both as a general introduction to the topic and as a brief, non-technical summary of the main results and their implications. Abstract should be unstructured, i.e. should not contain sections, or subheadings.

Keywords

Provide up to 6 keywords/key phrases representing the main content of the submission.

Manuscript

Your manuscript text file should start with the following:

Title of the Article
Author/s
. Affiliation
Contact email/s of the author/s

For the main body of the text, the author can organize it in a way that best suits for your research findings and outcomes/ conclusion. However, the following structure is recommended to maintain the uniformity of the journal.

- Introduction
- Literature Review
- Data, Results, and Discussion (without subheadings)
- Methods
- Conclusion

The authors are required to follow the main body of text with:

- List of Figures, List of Tables (if any)
